


AGGREKO INTERNATIONAL



Founded in the Netherlands more than 50 years ago, Aggreko International, the largest specialist power generation rental company in the world, has been shortlisted for the DuPont Safety and Sustainability Awards on the basis of the safety performance improvement achieved at its international projects hub located in the Jebel Ali Free Zone in Dubai.



Aggreko International has provided high-quality power generation and temperature control rental solutions in the Middle East for over 20 years, both through 'local' businesses (depots) spread across Saudi Arabia, Kuwait, Bahrain, Qatar, the United Arab Emirates, Oman and Kazakhstan, and through a special global 'projects' business catering for multi-megawatt power packages serviced from the regional headquarters in Dubai. Operational since 1999, the Jebel Ali facility's activities range from equipment refurbishment to the movement of fleet.

In line with Aggreko International's commitment to promoting a safety culture and ensuring continual improvements in safety performance, the company embarked upon a vigorous training program to implement DuPont™ STOP™ and SafeStart® safety programs at the Jebel Ali facility in August 2010. The initiative was aimed at altering habits to eliminate incidents and injuries, raise overall safety awareness, improve organizational communication and observation, and develop safety leadership.

A rigorous method of data collection



An effective strategy for communicating safety analysis and trends

To achieve these goals, Aggreko International's trained project leaders focused on improving three key aspects of safety management to shape a valuable 'early warning' system: an anticipatory approach to safety observation, a rigorous method of data collection, and an effective strategy for communicating safety analysis and trends. The results have been impressive, including a consistent improvement in hazard and risk reporting, a dramatic reduction in personal injuries, and as of June 2013, the milestone of 1170 days free of lost time incidents in a workforce of over 500 people.
